

The Fight for Rights

A Research and Google Presentation Project

The fight for rights has a long history in the US. We recently learned about the Civil Rights Movement, which helped bring equality for African Americans. In this project you will work with a partner to create a google slideshow presentation on another movement or person who was part of the fight for rights in US History.

Step 1: Research

You'll begin with research, using books from our library and the Gale Group database, accessed from your Chromebook. Your first step is to learn as much as you can about a person or movement whom was involved in the fight for rights. Answer the the research questions as you find information.

Step 2: Planning a Google Slide Presentation

Once you have gathered your information, you will use the slideshow presentation template to sketch out your google slide presentation. Pencil in the card titles and information for your eight cards. Indicate the colors you will use and the types of photos you want.

Step 3: Design Your Slide Presentation

Using your research and slide template, design your slide presentation. You will make eight cards. Be sure to start with the title card, followed by six information cards. The final card will include your works cited, a list of the sources you used in your project.

Step 4: Present Your Slide Presentation to the Class

With your slide presentation projected behind you, give an oral report to the class about your person or movement. Move through your slides as you explain your topic.

Grading

You will be graded according to the Fight for Your Rights Rubric. You can earn up to 100 points including: 25 points for your research and planning, 50 points for your slideshow, and 25 points for your oral presentation.
