Interview of an Immigrant

Each student will interview a new American. You may choose an immigrant who is a school friend, family member, relative, or person from the school or community. After the interview is typed up, students will design a web page. The web page will include a header, the text of the interview, accompanied by photographs or scanned images.

- **Step 1:** Students interview Immigrant, taking rough notes on the interview sheet.
- **Step 2:** Students write and type the interview including: a third person introduction, a first person body and conclusion.
- **Step 3:** Students use computer art tools to design a header with the person's name and title of the interview, along with photographs and scanned images of the person.
- **Step 4:** Students assemble the text and graphic elements of the interview into a finished web page.

Grading:

Each aspect of the assignment will be worth 25 points for a total of 100 points.

Step 2 Instructions: Writing up the Interview:

Organize the typed interview into four sections. (Some parts may be several paragraphs long depending on the most interesting aspects of your interviewee's story and the details that you gathered.)

- **Section 1:** The first paragraph focuses on third person description of interviewee
- **Section 2:** Paragraphs written in the first person focus on the native land of the interviewee and the trip to the US (details from questions 2, 3,4)
- **Section 3:** Paragraphs written in the first person focus on on life in the US (questions 5, 6,7,8)
- **Section 4:** The concluding paragraph is a reflection of the person written in the first person. (details from questions 9,10)
