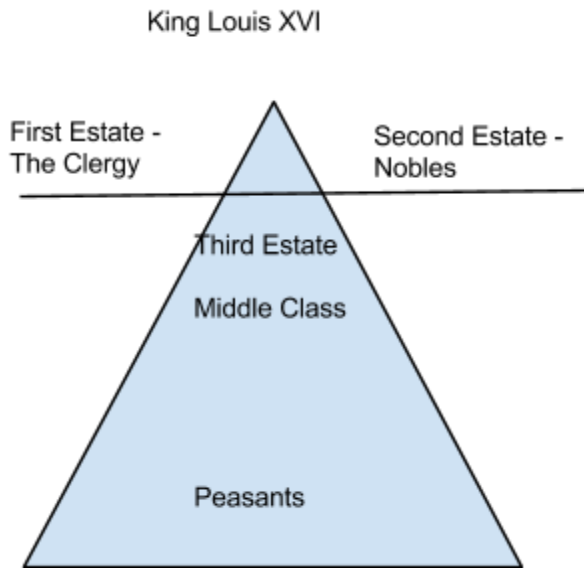


The Social Structures of France in 1789 and Tsarist Russia
